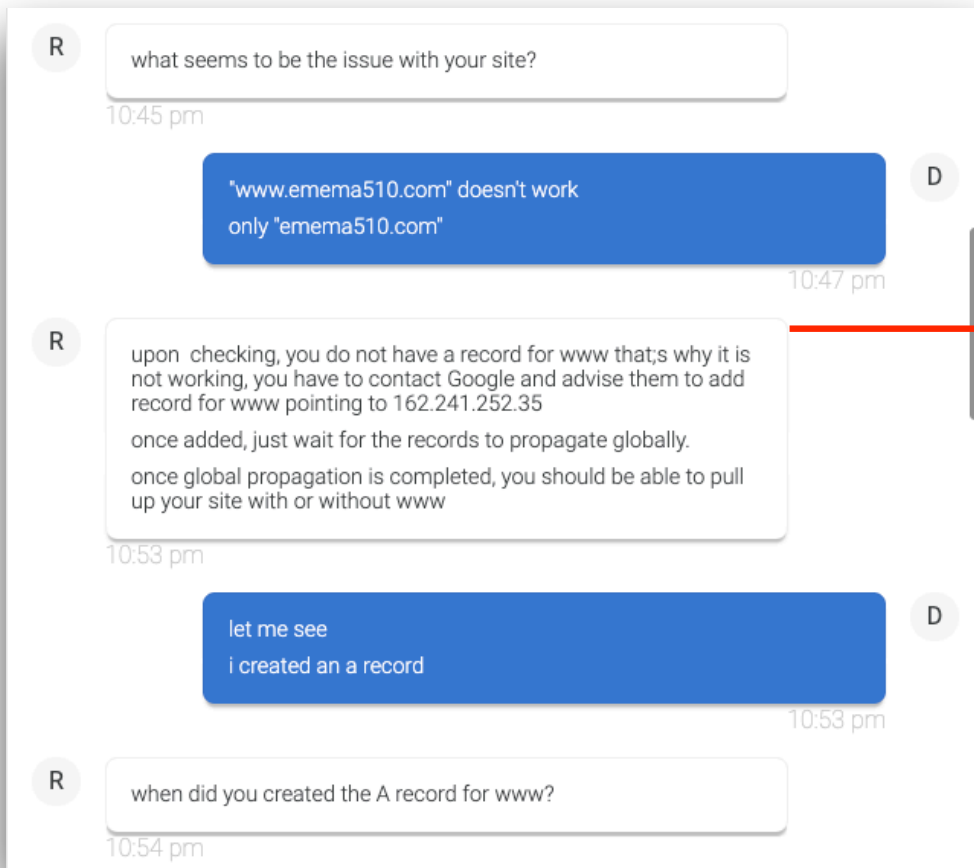

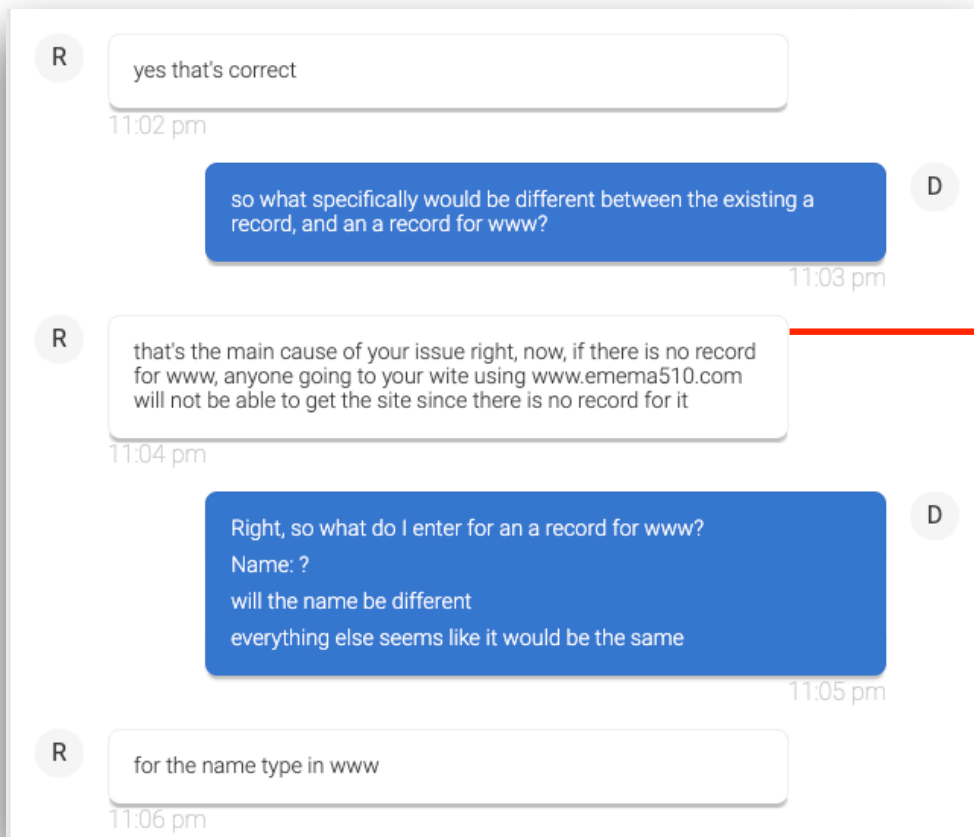

So after this chat with BlueHost, I created another A record for “www” the next day. Per my annotations in Conversation #2, I mentioned that the technician was trying to get me to visit the following website: www.whatsmydns.net

I can’t recall exactly what was displayed on that site, but I vaguely recall something with my website name not being propagated to servers in China.

Anyway, so I ended this conversation with BlueHost and created the A record for “www” and the website was propagated globally within the same hour. However, when I visited whatsmydns.net to check the propagation status, the website name was successfully propagated globally except for one location, and I doubt the location is by random coincidence and was definitely intentionally to send some kind of message to me. As you can see on the next page, the only location where my website name wasn’t propagated was Boston, MA. So what’s the significance of this location. Well, as I mention in a blog post, which was posted on Blogger, regarding cyberstalking, I mentioned that I worked for a startup and the day I quit was a day after Aaron Swartz committed suicide, and that I wasn’t aware of this until more than a year

after... well, I thought he was from Boston, but per Wikipedia he’s not. However, he did attend Harvard University, which is in Boston, which is also where MIT is, which is where he “hacked” servers. So now I’m definitely convinced that when that BlueHost technician in Conversation #2 was acting like he could change my domain name settings on my behalf, which in hindsight seems like a security flaw and not possible and could have been alluding to his “ability to hack,” was definitely alluding to hacking.

Now why would this technician allude to hacking. Is it because Apple has allowed people to cyber stalk my electronics and I’ve talked about how my electronic devices are hacked on my blogs? Is it because my current cyberstalkers don’t want me to write about my current situation and how they are cyberstalking me? Probably because he did write “stay safe.”

Now why would my domain name not propagate to servers in Boston, MA or appear so on whatsmydns.net website? Are they trying to tell me to commit suicide (eww super gross)? Are they trying to tell me that I’m making them look bad? I don’t know.
